How many of you are subscribing to Quality's Computer new magazine for Apple only?

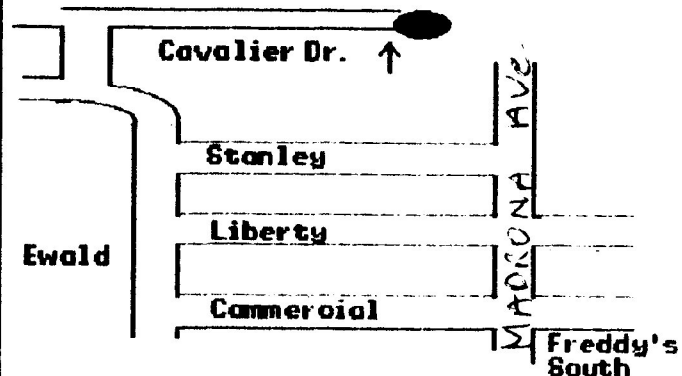
I don't, as of yet, but may have to in order to stay on
